Thirty-seven events from South Australia and interstate are currently registered with more coming in with our rolling registration program, so there's plenty to whet the appetites of local lovers of cabaret.

To get things rolling, we're inviting you to attend the special media launch at La Boheme on Friday 1 May, from 11am-noon.

Entertainment will be provided by Adelaide favourite Hans (aka Matt Gilbertson), who is presenting Hans' Haus Party for one night only at the German Club; the fabulous Fabulettes, who'll be bringing back the 60s with their show She's So Fine; and the Geek Pop Quiz, who will take you on a musical journey through time to visit the songs we love and the songs we best forget.

Co-director of the Cabaret Fringe, Eugene Suleau, is excited by the variety in this year's programme. "There's some old favourites, such as last year's hit 'Candy Chambers: 50 Forever' returning for another season, plus there's some artists making their Cab Fringe debut, such as Hannah Bennett who is presenting 'Myriad' at the Kevin Crease Studios at Channel 9.

Fellow co-director Paul Boylan says "Our message to audiences this year is Lose Yourself in Our World: there's so much to experience at Cabaret Fringe that you pretty much can't go wrong whatever you see. So get out and see as much as you can!"

This year the Cab Fringe is indulging in all things feminine, from Pin Up National winner Miss Porcelain in her Burlesque show 'The Garden of Eden' to an intellectual view on striptease with Irene Nicola in 'A Postmodern Striptease' Cabaret Fringe 2015 is definitely lifting the lid on the female perspective.
